Bradford Sr., deceased, and Mary Bradford, his wife, to in consideration of Twenty-five Dollars, to them paid by D. C. Gilman, do hereby remise, release and forever Quitclaim unto the said D. C. Gilman and unto his heirs and assigns all their right, title and interest in and to the following described parcel of real estate, situate in County of Thurman, State of Washington, to-wit:

Beginning at the Columbia River at the North East corner of the Survey of the D. F. Bradford Donation Land Claim; thence North $54\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ West 50 chains; thence South 29° West 55 chains, to the place of beginning; thence South 23° East 42 chains and fifty links; thence East 3 chains and 95 links; thence South 30 chains; thence West 55 chains; thence North 77 chains; thence East 45 chains to the intersection of the D. F. Bradford Donation Land Claim; thence South 29° West 12 chains to the place of beginning, and being the Donation Land Claim of Isaac H. Bush and Julia Ann Bush his wife and conveyed or intended to be conveyed by them to Putnam F. Bradford Sr. now deceased by deed dated Feb'y 28, 1865 and recorded March 1st 1865 in Book A at page 149 of the records of Deeds of said County. It being the intention of the above named grantors to hereby sell and convey unto the above named grantee his heirs and assigns all of their right, title and interest of in and to the Donation Land Claim of Isaac H. Bush and Julia Ann Bush his wife, in Township Two North of Range Seven East of the Willamette Meridian in said County.

To Have and to Hold, the same, together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining to the said D. C. Gilman and to his heirs and assigns forever.
