Lowden to Cobb

This Indenture made this 3rd day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and ten between H.C.Lowden and Adelaide A.Lowden his wife of Underwood, Skamania County Washington, parties of the first part, and Edwin R.Cobb, party of the second part, witnesseth:

That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of one thousand (\$1000.00) dollars lawful money of the United states to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey and warrant unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns the following described tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington to-wit: Beginning at a point from which the corner to sections 14, 15, 22 and 23 Tp.3 N.R.10 E.W.M. bears N. 39° 48' East 1327.6 feet distant, said point being the middle of the south line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 15. Thence northward 660 feet along the line common to the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ and the Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section 15; thence westward 198 feet on a line parallel with the south line of said quarter section, thence southward 660 feet to the south line of said quarter section, thence eastward 198 feet to point of beginning, containing three acres, saving and excepting therefrom a strip of land seven and one half feet in width along the east side of said tract which is reserved for road purposes. , Together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto be longing.
