This Indenture Witnesseth, That C. C. Brown, Castle Rock Washington, party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars in currency of the United States of America, to me in hand paid by Thomas A. Beall, Lewiston Illinois, party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, his revised, released and forever quitclaimed one half interest, and by these presents do sell, release, release and forever quitclaim one half interest unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns, the following described premises, situated, lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to wit:

Consisting of four Mineral Claims about 20 acres each and four Mill sites about 5 acres each. Situated about 3 miles west of the outlet - Spirit Lake and about 1 mile north of the Touchet River and located on and near the first large baron on Touchet River $\frac{1}{2}$ east of Lou Bright's homestead and as near as can be described located in Section 8 Township 9 North Range 5 East, Township has been surveyed but not accepted.
