

E. H. Prindle to P. & S. Ry Co.

Right of Way Deed.

The Grantees for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, as herein paid, convey and warrant to the Portland and Seattle Railway Company, a Washington corporation, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate situated in the County of Stevens, State of Washington, viz: A strip of land one hundred feet in width being fifty feet in width on each side of the center line of the railroad of said Railway Company, as now located, staked out and to be constructed over and across Lot four and that part of lots two and three of section eleven and that part of lot one of section twelve, that is owned by us, in Township one north, range first east of Willamette Meridian, and the boundaries adjacent thereto, including the preference right of the grantees herein to purchase the portion of said shore lands contained within said strip, said consideration also being in full settlement of all claims and demands for damage sustained by reason of the location, construction, maintenance and operation of said railroad on, over and across said land.

Said Railway Company is to provide two private road crossings at suitable and convenient places upon said premises to enable the grantees to reach their premises on either side of said strip of land and to fence said right of way on both sides wherever the same is necessary. Reserving unto the grantees the right to follow upon and under said strips of land any vein of mineral which may be discovered upon the adjacent lands and to remove the minerals therefrom, provided that such right shall be so exercised as not to damage the property of the said railway company or interfere with its use for railroad purposes.
