This Indenture made this 14th day of May 1910 be and between Stanley Eastman, single, mortgagor, and Harry E. Brown of The Dalles, Ore, Mortgagee, witnesseth: That the mortgagor for an in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto said mortgagee his heirs and assigns forever all the following described real estate situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington to-wit: The Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section ten (10), Township three (3) North of Range nine (9) East of Willamette meridian, containing ten (10) acres according to U.S. Survey, save and except twenty feet off the east side to be used for County Road purposes. Together with the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold unto the mortgagee his heirs and assigns forever. On or before two years after date without grace I promise to pay to the order of Harry E. Brown at The Dalles Oregon five hundred dollars in Gold Coin of the United States of America of the present standard value with interest therein in like gold coin at the rate of 8 per cent per annum from date until paid for value received. Interest to be paid annually and if not so paid the whole sum of both principal and interest to become immediately due and collectible at the option of the holder of this note. And in case suit or action is instituted to collect this note or any portion thereof I premise to pay in addition to the costs and disbursements provided by statute such additional sum as the Court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys
