Sandell to La Barre

This Indenture Witnesseth that I, George Sandell (an unmarried man) party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar to me in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and convey unto Julia C. La Barre party of the second part the following described premises to-wit: The fractional Northeast quarter of section twenty seven (27) in Township two (2) North of Range five (5) East of Willamette Meridian, save and except and excluding from this conveyance forty acres described as follows: The East  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the Northeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the Northeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  and the East  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the Southeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the Northeast  $\frac{1}{4}$  of said section 27, meaning an intending hereby to convey one hundred and twenty-one and fifty eight hundredths (121.58) acres, being the remainder of the Northeast quarter of said section 27. Together with tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belong or in anywise appertaining. To have and to hold the same with the appurtenances unto the said Julia C. La Barre her heirs and assigns forever.
