

Rands, of the City of Portland of Multnomah County, State of Oregon, have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said E. M. Rands, and unto his heirs and assigns, all the following bounded and described real property, situate in the County of Skamania and State of Washington to wit:— All of lots numbered Three (3) and Four (4) of section twenty five (25) all in Township Three North of Range Nine East of Willamette Meridian;— and being the same property which we acquired in two separate Warranty Deeds, the first dated November 7th 1905; and executed by Ada C. Baker and husband of Colorado Springs, Colorado; and intended to be recorded, the second dated November, 14th 1905, and executed by Claude E. Markham and wife, each deed conveying an undivided one half interest in and to the above described parcel of land. Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and also all our estate, right, title and interest in and to the same, including dower and claim of dower.
