

L. Gerbinger and Wife to Columbia Valley Railroad Company

Know all men by these presents, That Louis Gerbinger Sr. and wife Sophia Gerbinger of the County of Multnomah in the State of Oregon in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars paid by The Columbia Valley Railroad Company a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Washington, having its principal office at the city of Vancouver in the said State, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, ^{granted,} have bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Columbia Valley Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, the following described parcel of land, situate in Skamania County, in the State of Washington to wit:

A strip of land - 200 - feet in width, being - 100 - feet in width on each side of and parallel with, the center line of the main track of railroad, as the same is staked out and located over and across the lands of the said Grantors, situate in Skamania County, State of Washington and known and designated as follows:

Lot One (1) of Section Thirty Two (32) Township Three (3) North of Range Nine (9) East of the Willamette Meridian.

To have and to hold the said described premises unto the said Company, its successors and assigns forever, for the purpose of building and maintaining a railroad thereon, and to use the same for all legitimate railroad purposes.
