Kallack their heirs and assigns, all the following bounded and described real property, situated in the County of Skamania and State of Washington To-Wit:

All the South one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section nineteen (19) in Township three (3) North of range ten (10) East Willamette Meridian, Skamania County State of Washington containing eighty acres (80) more or less,

To Have and To Hold the above granted premises with all the rights, easements and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said George C. Kallack, W.M. Kallacks, their heirs and assigns forever. And the said grantors do covenant to and with the said grantee their heirs and assigns that they are lawfully seized in fee of the above granted premises; that they are free from all incumbrances, and that they will and their heirs, executors and administrators, shall, warrant and defend the above granted premises, to the said grantee his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

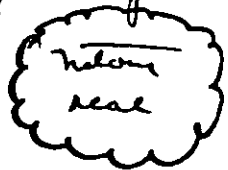
