Know All Men By These Presents, That we, Charles J. Stutling and Anna C. Stutling, husband and wife, in consideration of Two Hundred Fifty & no/100 Dollars to us in hand paid by the Oregon Lumber Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Utah and doing business in the State of Washington and elsewhere, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Oregon Lumber Company, its successors and assigns, all of the timber that has up to the present time been cut by it on the following described land situate in Skamania County, State of Washington, to-wit:

The North half of the North-west quarter of Section Ten, the North half of the North-east quarter of Section Nine Township Three North, Range Nine East, Willamette Meridian.

And we and each of us hereby release the said Oregon Lumber Company from all claims and demands that we or either of us now have or ever had against said Company, and especially do we and each of us release and discharge said Company from all claims or demands that we or either of us may now have against said Company on account of any trespass upon said described real estate.

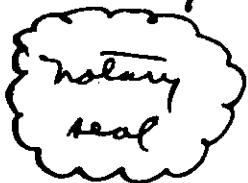
