

Santa Fee Pacific R.R. Co. to Col. Valley R.R. Co.

Know all Men by these Presents, That The Santa Fee Pacific Railroad Company, a corporation duly incorporated under act of Congress approved March 3, 1897, in consideration of the sum of Seventeen Hundred - Seventy <1770.00> Dollars, paid by the Columbia Valley Railroad Company, a corporation duly organized under the laws of Washington, having its principal office at the City of Vancouver in the ^{State}, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Columbia Valley Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, the following described parcel of land, situate in Skamania County, in the State of Washington, to-wit: A strip of land 200 feet in width, being 100 feet in width on each side of the said ~~road~~ ^{with the center line of the main track of railroad}, as the same is staked out and located over and across the lands of the said Santa Fee Pacific Railroad Co., situate in Skamania County, State of Washington and known and designated as follows:

Lots one <1> and <2> in sec. thirty four <34> T₃ S. N. R. 9 E. W. M.

To have and to hold the said described premises unto the said Company, its successors and assigns forever, for the purpose of building and maintaining a railroad thereon, and to use the same for all legitimate railroad purposes.
