Brice and unto his heirs and assigns, all my right, title and interest in and to the following described parcel of real estate, situate in County of Skamania State of Washington to-wit:

An undivided one-third ($\frac{1}{3}$) interest in and to the following described real property, to-wit: A certain Lode Mining claim, known as the Silver King and located on Blue Jacket Creek which is a tributary of the Blue Bird Creek, said claim being located at foot of falls on Blue Jacket Creek falls 14 ft high 30 feet high above falls connecting discovery at post No. 1. thence 300 feet in a northeasterly direction to corner post No. 2.
