S. C. Wills and to his heirs and assigns forever, all of that certain tract of land lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and particularly described as follows to-wit:

All our undivided one third right, title and interest in and to the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter  $\text{NW}^{\frac{1}{4}} \text{ of } \text{N.E.}^{\frac{1}{4}}$  of Section twenty seven  $\text{27}$  in Township three (3) North Range seven  $\text{7}$  East of Willamette Meridian, containing four acres more or less, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and all of our right, title, interest, claim, possession or demand of any kind whatever, whether at law or equity, of, in or to the above described premises, and each and every part and parcel thereof.
