

O.H. Mc Nutt et al to Fred Cocher et al

This Indenture, made the twenty first day of October in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and four between O.H. Mc Nutt and S.E. Mc Nutt husband and wife of Skamania County Washington, parties of the first part and Fred Cocher and Alfred Cocher parties of the second part witnesseseth; That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen dollars of the United States of America, to us in hand paid by the said parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained, sold, remised, released and forever quitclaimed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said parties of the second part and to their heirs and assigns all of our right title and interest to a certain spring or stream of water starting from the section line between sections eight and nine in Township One North of Range five East of the Willamette Meridian and running thence up said creek or stream of water four hundred and fifty four 4 feet more or less to a spring on the South bank of said creek or stream of water; Said parties of the second part to have the use and benefit of said spring. To have and to hold the right to lay a pipe from said spring down said creek or stream of water or as near said creek as practicable, also to maintain or keep up said pipe.


Said spring above described is situated in Skamania County Washington.
