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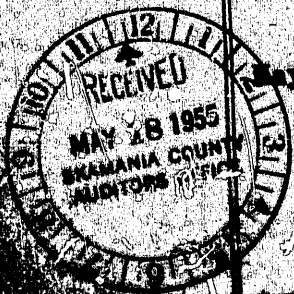
POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, Mark D. Woodward and Dorothy F. Woodward, his wife, of Luray, Page County, Virginia, have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint Robert V. And we hereby ratify and confirm all lawful acts done by our attorney by virtue hereof.
