Together with, all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and also all our estate, right, title and interest in and to the same, including Dower and claim of Dower.

Durvin her heirs and assigns forever, and we, Michael Fitzgerald and wife, grantor above named do covenant to and with Mrs Ellen F. Durvin, the above grantee, her heirs and assigns, that the above granted premises are free from all incumbrances and that we will and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the above granted premises and every part and parcel thereof, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whatsoever.
