

W. S. Thomas to Portland & Seattle Ry. Co.

The Grantors for and consideration of the sum of Four hundred Dollars (\$400.00) in hand paid, convey and warrant to the Portland and Seattle Railway Company, a Washington corporation, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate situate in the County of Skamania State of Washington, viz: A strip of land one hundred feet in width being fifty feet on each side of the center line of the railroad of said Company, is now located, staked out and to be constructed over and across that part of lot two owned by the grantors and the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of section six, Township one north range six east W. M. and the shorelands adjacent thereto, including the preference right of the grantors herein to purchase the portion of said shorelands contained within said strip, together with the privilege of obtaining necessary material for construction of said railroad across said premises, from lands outside of and adjacent to the above described strip, said consideration also being a full settlement of all claims and demands for damages sustained by reason of the location, construction, maintenance and operation of said railroad on, over and across said described land.

Said Railway Company to construct a wagon road across its railroad tracks near the center of the meadow or above described lands, if practicable.
