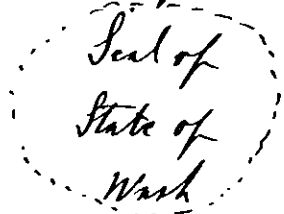


State of Washington to L. Gerligger

In consideration of Two Hundred Seventy-five and no/100 (\$275.00) Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the State of Washington does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto L. Gerligger, his heirs and assigns, the following described shore land of the second class, situated in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit: All shore lands owned by the State of Washington, situate in front of, adjacent to or abutting upon the government meander line described as follows: Commencing at the government meander post between sections sixteen (16) and seventeen (17), Township one (1) north, range five (5) east of the Willamette Meridian; thence along the government meander line down stream to near the center of section twenty (20) Township one (1) north, range five (5) east of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 55 chains measured along the government meander line.

To Have and to Hold the said premises, with their appurtenances unto the said L. Gerligger, his heirs and assigns forever.

The Grantor, L. Gerligger and Sophia Gerligger his wife, of Portland, Oregon, For and in consideration of Three Hundred and Fifty 00/100 in hand paid, convey and warrant as to grantors herein to The Columbia Valley Railroad Company, a corporation, the following described real estate, situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

All shore lands situate in front of, adjacent to or abutting upon the government meander line described as follows: Commencing at the government meander post between Sections sixteen (16) and seventeen (17) Township One (1) North, range five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian; thence along the government meander line down stream to near the center line of Section Twenty (20) Township One (1) North, range five (5) East of the W. M., being a total of Fifty-five (55) chains measured along the Government meander line.

Grantors retain the fishing rights and privileges adjoining, adjacent to and along said shore land with the right to cross and use said land in such manner as not to conflict with any railroad built and operated.
