

on said land, together with the privilege of obtaining necessary material for the construction of said railroad across said premises and lands outside of and adjacent to the above described strip. Said consideration also being in full settlement of all claims and demands for damages sustained by reason of the location, construction, maintenance and operation of said railroad on, over and across said premises. Full authority is hereby granted to enter upon the premises hereinabove described over and across which a right of way is granted for the purpose of marking definite location of said line of railroad. Upon the marking of said definite location and the staking out of said center line this deed shall operate as a conveyance of the fee simple title to the said described strips of land provided said definite location is made and said line staked out within one year from this date.
