Know all men by these Presents, That The Oregon Lumber Co. a corporation of the County of _____ in the State of Utah in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars, paid by the Columbia Valley Railroad Company, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Washington, having its principal office at the City of Vancouver in the said State, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents does grant, bargain sell and convey unto the said Columbia Valley Railroad Company, its successors and assigns, the following described parcel of land, situate in Skamania County in the State of Washington, to-wit:

A strip of land 100 feet in width, being 50 feet in width on each side of and parallel with, the center line of the main track of railroad, as the same is staked out and located over and across the lands of the said Oregon Lumber Co., a corporation, situate in Skamania County, State of Washington, and known and described as follows:

Lot four (4) in Sec. Thirty-four (34) Township Three (3) North, Range nine (9) East; of the Willamette Meridian.

To have and to hold the said premises unto its successors and assigns forever, for the purposes of building and maintaining a railroad thereon, and to use the same for all legitimate railroad purposes.
