

the preference right of the grantors herein to further the portion of said shore lands contained within said strip, together with the privilege of obtaining necessary material for construction of road railroad across said premises, from the lands outside of and adjacent to the above described strip, said consideration also being in full settlement of all claims and demands for damage sustained by reason of the location, construction, maintenance and operation of said railroad on, over and across said described land.

The railway company is to fence its said right of way on both sides where it crosses grantors property, where a fence is necessary, and grantors are to be allowed a crossing over said railway at some practicable place to allow them to reach their land in either side of said railroad.
