

from the Griggley Discovery Lode, and about four thousand feet Southeast of the Index Group of claims, running from said discovery in a southwesterly direction 300 feet to the southwesterly corner stake, thence 1500 feet in a southeasterly direction to the southeasterly corner stake, thence 300 feet in a westerly direction to the westerly end or center line stake, thence 300 feet in a northeasterly direction to the northeasterly corner stake, thence 1500 feet in a northwesterly direction to the northwesterly corner stake, thence 300 feet in a southwesterly direction to the discovery at the place of beginning.

XVIII. The Evening Lode Discovery No 2 Northwest, beginning adjacent to the discovery of the Evening Lode claim Discovery No 2 Northwest, described in the seventeenth paragraph above mentioned and running from said discovery in a southwesterly direction 300 feet to the southwest corner stake, thence in a northwesterly direction 1500 feet to the northwesterly corner stake, thence 300 feet in a northeasterly direction to the northwesterly end or center line stake, thence 300 feet in a northeasterly direction to the northwesterly corner stake, thence 1500 feet in a southeasterly direction to the northeasterly corner stake, thence 300 feet in a southwesterly direction to the place of beginning, at the discovery.

XIX. The Morning Lode Discovery No 1 Northeast, commencing at the discovery which is about thirty feet southeast from location notice placed on Larch tree about 12 inches in diameter and about 600 feet up the mountain from the valley and in Little Falls Creek, a tributary of the North Fork River and is on the North Slope of Griggley Creek Mountains and is about one half mile N.W. of the Griggley mine on Griggley Creek, running from said discovery 300 feet in a southeasterly direction to the southwesterly corner stake, thence 1500 feet in a northeasterly direction to the southeasterly corner stake, thence 300 feet in a northwesterly direction to the northeasterly center end line stake, thence 300 feet in a northwesterly direction to the northeasterly corner stake, thence 1500 feet in a southwesterly direction to the northwesterly corner stake, thence 300 feet in a southeasterly direction to the discovery, at the point of beginning.

XX. The Morning Lode Discovery claim No 2 Southwest, commencing at the discovery point, which is adjacent to the discovery of the Morning Lode Discovery No 1 Northeast, mentioned in the nineteenth paragraph herein, running thence in a southeasterly direction three hundred feet to the southeasterly corner stake, thence in a southwesterly direction 1500 feet to the southwesterly corner stake, thence 300 feet in a northwesterly direction to the southwest center end stake, thence 300 feet in a northwesterly direction to the northwesterly corner stake, thence 1500 feet in a northeasterly direction to the northeasterly corner stake, thence 300 feet in a southeasterly direction to the point of beginning, at the discovery.

XXI. The Star Queen Lode Second Discovery claim No 1 East, commencing at the discovery which is about three hundred feet east of Summit Lake and on the southwest slope of Strawberry range of mountains and is bounded on the east by Star Queen Lode First Discovery No 2 West, running from said discovery point in a southerly direction 300 feet to the southwest corner stake, thence 1500 feet in an easterly direction to the southeast corner stake, thence 300 feet in a northerly direction to the east center end line stake, thence 300 feet in a northerly direction to the north east corner stake, thence 1500 feet in a westerly direction to the northwest corner stake, thence 300 feet in a southerly direction to the point of beginning, at the discovery.
