Know all men by these Presents, That I, George Murray of the County of Clarke in the State of Washington in consideration of One Dollar to me in hand paid by Mary Thurston of Skamania County, Washington the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby remise, release and forever disclaim unto the said Mary Thurston and unto her heirs and assigns all my right, title and interest in and to the following described premises, namely; Beginning at the North East Corner of the West $\frac{1}{2}$ of the North East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, Township 3, North of Range 8, East W.M., running thence South 80 rods; thence West 40 rods; thence North 80 rods; thence East to the place of beginning. Containing 20 acres of land. In Skamania County, Washington.

To Have and To Hold the same unto the said Mary Thurston and unto her heirs and assigns forever, with all the privilege and appurtenances thereto belonging, free from all claim thereon on the part of the said George Murray or any one claiming the same by, or through, or under him in any manner, whatsoever.
