Now therefore, in consideration of the premises and one dollar (\$1.00) duly paid to the Central Trust Company of New York by the Spokane Portland & Seattle Ry. Company, Central Trust Company of New York does hereby remise, release and quitclaim unto the Spokane Portland & Seattle Railway Company all the following described property to-wit:

All of Lots one (1) and two (2) and three (3) and the Northeast quarter of the southeast quarter and the Northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section twenty-eight (28) in Township three (3) North of Range eight (8) East of Willamette Meridian, in Skamania County Washington, excepting a certain strip of land four hundred (400) feet in width being two hundred feet in width on each side of the center line of the main track of the Spokane Portland and Seattle Ry. Co. as the same is now constructed and operated, and except a certain tract of land not owned or claimed by this company and situate on the northwest corner of said Lot one (1) and described as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of lot one running east on the north boundary thereof seven hundred twenty six (726); thence south three hundred (300) feet; thence west seven hundred twenty six (726) feet to the line between section 28 and 29, thence north along the line between said sections a distance of 300 feet to place of beginning. , the foregoing premises being at the station of Ash on the line of this company's railway.

Also all that portion of Lots one (1) two (2) and three (3) of section three (3) in Township two (2) North of Range twelve east of Willamette Meridian in Klickitat County Washington owned by the Spokane Portland & Seattle Ry. Co. situated east of the Klickitat River; and lying south of a line parallel with and two hundred fifty feet southerly of the center line of the main track of the Spokane Portland & Seattle Ry. Co. as the same is now constructed and operated over and across said section three, except a tract of land bounded by lines fifty feet distant from and parallel or concentric with the wye track of the Spokane Portland & Seattle Railway Company as now operated, said lines being on the southeasterly and westerly sides of said wye track and a line perpendicular to end of said wye track, being at the station of Lyle on the line of this company's railway.

And the said Central Trust company of New York does hereby declare that the said premises above described and no part thereof were included or intended to be included in the conveyance so made by the said indenture between said parties on May 1st 1908.
