In Consideration of Six hundred ninety-three and 50/100 (\$693.50) Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the State of Washington does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto S.S. Hayes and W.O. Hadley, their heirs and assigns, the following described school lands, situated in Skamania County, Lots one (1), two (2), and five (5), section thirty-six (36) Township three (3) North, range eight (8) East of the Willamette Meridian, containing 69.35 acres, more or less, according to the government survey thereof.

To Have and To Hold the said premises, with their appurtenances, unto the said S.S. Hayes and W.O. Hadley, their heirs and assigns forever.
