

Twenty-six degrees and thirty-nine minutes west two thousand two hundred and seventy-four and seventy-nine hundredths feet distant.

Thence fourth course magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east north sixty-four degrees and ten minutes east one thousand four hundred and thirty and three tenths feet to witness corner to said corner No. 1, a fir post six inches square marked W.C. 1-774 and W.C. 5-774; one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 1 the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Earl No. 1 vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Earl No. 2 lode claim at corner No. 1, identical with corner No. 3 of said Earl No. 1 lode claim, from which said section corner bears south seventy-eight degrees and eight minutes east one thousand two hundred and twenty-three and twenty-four hundredths feet distant.

Thence first course magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east north twenty-five degrees and fifty minutes west three hundred feet to a point from which discovery post bears south sixty-four degrees and ten minutes west ten feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No. 2, a fir post six inches square marked 2-774, 1-774, 4-774 and 3-774.

Thence second course magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east, south sixty-four degrees and ten minutes west one thousand four hundred and thirty-five and nine tenths feet intersect the north line of the Adamantite No. 2 lode claim survey No. 708 at west one hundred and eighty-eight and fifty-six hundredths feet from the north-east corner of said claim; one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 3, a fir post five inches square marked 3-774 and 4-774 in bed of pumice stone.

Thence third course, magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east south twenty-five degrees and fifty minutes east five hundred and sixty-five and one tenth feet intersect the east line of said Adamantite No. 2, lode claim, at south five hundred and thirty-six and fifty six hundredths feet from the northeast corner of said claim; six hundred feet to corner No. 4, identical with corner No. 4 of said Earl No. 1, lode claim and marked 4-774.

Thence fourth course magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east, north sixty-four degrees and ten minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Earl No. 2, vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Earl No. 3 lode claim at corner No. 1, identical with corner No. 2 of said Earl No. 2,
