

lode claim from which said section corner bears south sixty-one degrees, thirty minutes and thirty seconds east one thousand six hundred and fifty-nine and fifty-five hundredths feet distant.

Thence first course north twenty-five degrees and fifty minutes west three hundred feet to a point from which discovery post bears south sixty-four degrees and ten minutes west ten feet distant; six hundred feet to corner no. 2, a fir post four inches square marked 2-774, 1-774, 4-774 and 3-774.

Thence second course, magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east, south sixty-four degrees and ten minutes west one thousand five hundred feet to corner no. 3, a fir post four inches square marked 3-774 and 4-774.

Thence third course magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east, south twenty-five degrees and fifty minutes east five hundred and sixty-eight and ninety-seven hundredths feet intersect the north line of said Adamantine No. 2 lode claim; six hundred feet to corner no. 4, identical with corner no. 3, of said Earl No. 2, lode claim, from which said U.S. location monument no. 4, bears south nine degrees, four minutes and thirty seconds west three thousand one hundred and fifty-two and thirty-seven hundredths feet distant.

Thence fourth course, north sixty-four degrees and ten minutes east sixty-four and one tenth feet intersect said north line of the Adamantine No. 2, lode claim; one thousand five hundred feet to corner no. 1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Earl No. 3 vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Earl No. 4, lode claim at corner no. 1, identical with corner no. 2, of said Earl No. 3, lode claim, from which said section corner bears south fifty-two degrees and fifteen minutes east two thousand one hundred and seventy five and thirty one hundredths feet distant.

Thence first course magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east, north twenty-five degrees and fifty minutes west three hundred feet to a point from which discovery post bears south sixty-four degrees and ten minutes west five feet distant; six hundred feet to corner no. 2, a fir post six inches square marked 2-774 and 3-774.

Thence, second course, magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east, south sixty-four degrees and ten minutes west one thousand three hundred and twelve and one tenth feet intersect the east line of the Genith No. 2, lode claim survey no. 708, at north
