

Two hundred and thirty four feet from the southeast corner of said claim; one thousand five hundred feet to corner no. 3, a fir post six inches square marked 3-774, with mound of stone.

Thence, third course, magnetic variation twenty-four degrees east, south twenty-five degrees and fifty minutes east one hundred and sixty-nine and two hundredths feet intersect the south line of said vein no. 2, lode claim, and the north line of the Ardentine no. 2, lode claim survey no. 708, at west ninety five and forty-two hundredths feet from the southeast corner of said vein no. 2, and the southeast corner of said Ardentine no. 2, lode claim; three hundred and eighty-eight feet intersect the east line of said Ardentine no. 2, lode claim, at south one hundred and ninety-seven and one tenth feet from the northeast corner of said claim; six hundred feet to corner no. 4 identical with corner no. 3, lode claim, from which said U.S. location monument no. 4, bears south three degrees and forty-two minutes west three thousand six hundred and sixty and eighty-five hundredths feet distant.

Thence, fourth course, north sixty-four degrees and ten minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner no. 1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said vein no. 4, vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Earl no. 5, lode claim at corner no. 1, a fir post four inches square marked 1-774 and 2-774, from which said section corner bears south ten degrees and thirty-three minutes, east two thousand and nineteen and fifty-four hundredths feet distant.

Thence, first course, magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east, north twenty-five degrees and fifty minutes west six hundred feet to corner no. 2, a fir post four inches square marked 2-774 with mound of stone.

Thence second course, magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east south sixty-four degrees and ten minutes west one thousand five hundred feet to corner no. 3 identical with corner no. 2, of said Earl no. 4, lode claim.

Thence, third course, south; twenty-five degrees and fifty minutes east three hundred feet to a point from which discovery post bears north sixty-four degrees and ten minutes east ten and seven tenths feet distant; six hundred feet to corner no. 4, identical with corner no. 2 of said Earl no. 3 lode claim, from which said U.S. location monument no. 4, bears south twenty degrees and
