Thence, fourth course, north sixty-four degrees and ten minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Earl No. 5 vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Earl No. 6, lode claim at corner No. 1, a fir post six inches square marked 1-774 and 2-774 from which said section corner bears south four degrees and eighteen minutes east one thousand four hundred and forty-nine and forty-two hundredths feet distant.

Thence, first course, magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east north twenty-five degrees and fifty minutes west six hundred feet to corner No. 2, identical with corner No. 1, of said Earl No. 5, lode claim.

Thence, second course, south sixty-four degrees and ten minutes west one thousand five hundred feet, to corner No. 3, identical with corner No. 2, of said Earl No. 3 lode claim and corner No. 4 of said Earl No. 5 lode claim.

Thence, third course, south twenty-five degrees and fifty minutes east three hundred feet to a point from which discovery post bears north sixty-four degrees and ten minutes east eleven feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No. 4, identical with corner No. 2 of said Earl No. 2 lode claim.

Thence, fourth course, north sixty-four degrees and ten minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Earl No. 6 vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Earl No. 7, lode claim at corner No. 1, a fir post six inches square marked 1-774 and 2-774 from which said section corner bears south nine degrees and thirty-five minutes west nine hundred and eighteen and twelve hundredths feet distant.

Thence first course magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east, north twenty-five degrees and fifty minutes west six hundred feet to corner No. 2, identical with corner No. 1 of said Earl No. 6 lode claim.

Thence, second course, south sixty-four degrees and ten minutes west one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 3, identical with corner No. 2 of said Earl No. 2 lode claim.

Thence, third course, south twenty-five degrees and fifty minutes east three hundred feet to a point from which discovery post bears north sixty-four degrees and ten minutes east eight feet distant; six hundred feet to corner No. 4 identical with
