

corner no. 3, of said Earl No. 1 lode claim, from which said U.S. location monument no. 4, bears south thirty-three degrees and ten minutes west three thousand eight hundred and fifty four and eighty-one hundredths feet distant.

Thence, fourth course, north sixty-four degrees and ten minutes east one thousand five hundred feet to corner no. 1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Earl No. 7 vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Earl No. 8 lode claim at corner no. 1, in brook and not established, from which said section corner bears south forty-eight degrees and thirty-six minutes west five hundred and fifty-two and thirty-five hundredths feet distant and a witness corner to said corner no. 1, a larch post six inches square marked W.C. 1-774 and W.C. 4-774, bears south sixty-four degrees and ten minutes west three and three tenths feet distant.

Thence, first course, magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east, north twenty-five degrees and fifty minutes west six hundred feet to corner no. 2, identical with corner no. 1 of said Earl No. 7 lode claim.

Thence, second course, south sixty-four degrees and ten minutes west one thousand five hundred feet to corner no. 3, identical with corner no. 3, of said Earl No. 1, lode claim.

Thence, third course, south twenty-five degrees and fifty minutes east three hundred feet to corner no. 4, identical with corner no. 2, of said Earl No. 1 lode claim, from which survey post bears east twenty-three and five tenths feet distant; six hundred feet to corner no. 5, in washout and not established from which said U.S. location monument no. 4 bears south forty-one degrees and twenty-five minutes west three thousand five hundred and eighty-two and seventy-two hundredths feet distant, and a witness corner to said corner no. 5, identical with witness corner to corner no. 1, of said Earl No. 1, lode claim, bears south sixty-four degrees and two minutes west sixty-nine and seven tenths feet distant.

Thence, fourth course, north sixty-four degrees and ten minutes east one hundred and fifty-three and three tenths feet to witness corner to said corner no. 5, a cedar post six inches square marked W.C. 5-774, and W.C. 1-774 in mound of stone; one thousand five hundred feet to corner no. 1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Earl No. 8, vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Earl No. 9 lode claim at corner no. 1 a fir post six inches square marked 1-774, situated on
