

east six hundred and ninety-eight and seven tenths feet to corner no. 3, a larch post six inches square marked 3-774.

Thence, third course magnetic variation twenty-two degrees and thirty minutes east north five degrees east one thousand five hundred feet to corner no. 4, identical with corner no. 1, of said Earl no. 8, lode claim.

Thence fourth course magnetic variation, twenty-two degrees and thirty minutes east south sixty-four degrees and ten minutes west three hundred and forty-nine and thirty-five hundredths feet to a point from which discovery post bears south five degrees west seven and five-tenths feet distant; six hundred and ninety-eight and seven tenths feet to corner no. 1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Earl no. 10, vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Earl no. 11 lode claim at corner no. 1, identical with corner no. 1 of said Earl no. 10 lode claim.

Thence, first course, magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east south sixty-four degrees and ten minutes west three hundred and forty-nine and thirty-five hundredths feet to a point from which discovery post bears south five degrees west sixteen feet distant; six hundred and forty-eight feet to witness corner to corner no. 2, identical with witness corner to corner no. 1, of said Earl no. 1, and corner no. 5 of said Earl no. 8 lode claims, also marked U.S. 2-774; six hundred and ninety-eight and seven tenths feet to corner no. 2, in washout and not established.

Thence, second course, magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east, south five degrees west one thousand five hundred feet to corner no. 3, a fir post six inches square marked 3-774 and 4-774 from which said U.S. location monument no. 4 bears south sixty-two degrees and three minutes west two thousand six hundred and thirty-nine and seventy-four hundredths feet distant.

Thence third course magnetic variation twenty-two degrees and thirty minutes east, north sixty-four degrees and ten minutes east six hundred and ninety-eight and seven tenths feet to corner no. 4, identical with corner no. 2, of said Earl no. 10, lode claim.

Thence, fourth course, magnetic variation twenty-two degrees and thirty minutes east, north five degrees east one thousand five hundred feet to corner no. 1 the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Earl no. 11, vein or lode.
