

Beginning for the description of the Earl No. 12 lode claim at corner No. 1, in wash-out and not established, from which said section corner bears north seventy-three degrees and fifty-three minutes east eight hundred and seventy-seven and nine tenths feet distant.

Thence, first course, magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east, south sixty-four degrees and ten minutes west one hundred and seventy-two and three tenths feet to witness corner to corner No. 5 of said Earl No. 8 and corner No. 1 of said Earl No. 1, lode claims, also marked W.C. 1-774; three hundred and forty-nine and thirty five hundredths feet to a point from which discovery post bears south five degrees west thirteen and eight tenths feet distant; six hundred and ninety-eight and seven tenths feet to corner No. 2, a hemlock post six inches square marked 2-774 and 1-774.

Thence, second course, magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east, south five degrees west one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 3, a larch post six inches square marked 3-774 and 4-774, from which said U.S. location monument No. 4, bears south sixty-one degrees and seventeen minutes west one thousand nine hundred and forty-one and seventy-eight hundredths feet distant.

Thence third course magnetic variation twenty-two degrees and thirty minutes east, north sixty-four degrees and ten minutes east six hundred and ninety-eight and seven tenths feet to corner No. 4, identical with corner No. 3 of said Earl No. 1, lode claim.

Thence, fourth course, magnetic variation twenty-two degrees and thirty minutes east, north five degrees east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 1, the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Earl No. 12 vein or lode.

Beginning for the description of the Earl No. 13 lode claim at corner No. 1, identical with corner No. 2 of said Earl No. 12 lode claim from which said section corner bears north sixty-nine degrees and thirty-five minutes east one thousand five hundred and seventy and ninety-seven hundredths feet distant.

Thence, first course, magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east, south sixty-four degrees and ten minutes west three hundred and forty-nine and thirty-five hundredths feet to a point from which discovery post bears south five degrees west sixteen feet distant; six hundred and ninety-eight and seven tenths feet to corner No. 2, a hemlock post six inches square marked 2-774, from which corner No. 5 of said Earl No. 1 lode claim bears south sixty-four degrees and ten minutes west two hundred and
