

ten minutes west two hundred and five and two tenths feet distant.

Thence second course magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east, south five degrees, west one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 3 a hemlock post six inches square marked 3-774, from which said U.S. location monument No. 4 bears south fifty-nine degrees and forty one minutes west one thousand two hundred and forty-four and two tenths feet distant.

Thence third course magnetic variation twenty-three degrees east, north sixty-four degrees and ten minutes east six hundred and ninety-eight and seven tenths feet to corner No. 4 identical with corner No. 3 of said Earl No. 15 lode claim.

Thence fourth course, north five degrees east one thousand five hundred feet to corner No. 1 the place of beginning; the survey of the lode claim as above described extending one thousand five hundred feet in length along said Earl No. 13 vein or lode.

Expressly, excepting and excluding from these presents all that portion of the ground, heretofore described embraced in said Adamantine No. 2, Gemuth No. 2, and Ardentine No. 2, lode claims survey No. 708, and also all veins, lodes and ledges throughout their entire depth, the tops or apexes of which lie inside of such excluded ground; the granted premises in said lot No. 774 containing two hundred and sixty-six acres and one hundred and forty-eight thousandths of an acre of land, more or less.

Now Know All, That there is therefore hereby granted by the United States unto the said Henry W. Cole and to his heirs and assigns, the said mining premises heretofore described, and not expressly excepted from these presents, and all that portion of the said Earl No. 1, Earl No. 2, Earl No. 3, Earl No. 4, Earl No. 5, Earl No. 6, Earl No. 7, Earl No. 8, Earl No. 9, Earl No. 10, Earl No. 11, Earl No. 12, Earl No. 13 veins, lodes, ledges, and of all other veins, lodes, and ledges, throughout their entire depth, the tops or apexes of which lie inside of the surface boundary lines of said granted premises in said Lot No. 774 extended downward vertically, although such veins, lodes, or ledges in their downward course may so far depart from a perpendicular as to extend outside the vertical side lines of said premises: Provided, That the right of possession to such outside parts of said veins, lodes, or ledges, shall be confined to such portions thereof as lie between vertical lines drawn downward through the end lines of said lot No. 774 so continued in their own direction that such planes will intersect such exterior parts of said veins, lodes, or ledges; And provided
