

H. G. Hill to Ernest Herman

This Indenture, made the 11th day of March in the year of our Lord Nineteen Hundred Five, witnesseth: That H. G. Hill, of Blaine, Whatcom County, Washington, party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to him in hand paid by Ernest Herman, of Blaine, Whatcom County, Washington, party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargains, sell, alien, remise, release, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever, all of the following described real estate, situated in Skagit County, State of Washington, to wit:

The undivided one ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) half interest in the  $\frac{1}{2}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and Lots one (1) and two (2) of Sec. 19, Twp. three (3) North, Range nine (9) East W. M. Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or appertaining thereto, and also all his estate, right, title, interest, dominion, claim of dower and homestead, and the rents, issues and profits of, in and to said real estate; To Have and to Hold the same to the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever. And the said party of the first part does covenant with the said party of the second part that the said real estate be free from all encumbrances and that he will and his heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whosoever.
