Right of Way Grant.

The Grantors for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred fifty ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ (\$550.00) Dollars, is here paid, convey and warrant to the Portland and Seattle Railway Company, a Washington corporation its successors and assigns, the following described real estate in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, viz: A strip of land one hundred feet in width being fifty feet on each side of the center line of the railroad of said Railway Company, is now located, staked out and to be constructed over and across the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter (NW¹/₄ of SE¹/₄ of Section 34 Township 2. north Range 6 East W. M. and the Shorelands adjacent thereto, including the preforementioned right of the grantors herein to purchase the portion of said shorelands contained within said strip, together with the privilege of obtaining necessary material for construction of said railroad across and premises, from lands outside of and adjacent to the above described strip said consideration also being in full settlement of all claims and demands for damage sustained by reason of the location, construction and maintenance and operation of said railroad over and across said described land.
