ministrators or assigns shall have the right to have included in the judgment which may be recovered, the sum as the court shall adjudge reasonable as attorney's fees, to be taxed as part of the cost in such suit, as well as all payments which said party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns may be obliged to make for his or their security by insurance or on account of any taxeds, charges, incum brances or assessments whatsoever on the said premises or any part thereof.

In case of the foreclosure of this mortgage, the party of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns shall be entitled to have entered in such foreclosure suit a judgment for any deficiency remaining due upon account of the indebtedness secured hereby, including taxes, insurance or other lawful assessments after applying the proceeds of the sale of the premises above described to the payment thereof, and to the costs of such foreclosure suit.
