Interet to be paid semi-annually. And if not so haid the whole sum of both principals and interest to be me immediately due and collectible at the opton og the holder of this note.

And in case suff or action is instituted to collect this note or any portion thereof, I we or either of us promise to pay in addition to the costs and disbursments provided by statute such additional sum in like gold coin as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorneys fees in said suit or action. Payment in even multiples of \$500.00 may be made on this note at any interest paying date after two years.
