

This Indenture made this 28th day of September 1910 between John P. Aplin and Rose J. Aplin husband and wife of Bellingham Whatcom County Washington the parties of the first part, and Sylvester A. Skinner, party of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of nine hundred and twenty five (\$925.00) dollars gold coin of the United States to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do by these presents grant bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns the following described tract; parcel or piece of land lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington to-wit:

Beginning at a point thirty (30) feet east and one hundred twenty two (122) rods and ten (10) feet north of the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section twenty one (21) Township three (3) North of Range nine (9) East of Willamette Meridian, running thence East fifty eight (58) rods and thirteen two thirds feet (13-2/3); thence north nineteen (19) rods and fourteen (14) feet; thence west fifty eight (58) rods and thirteen and two third (13-2/3) feet; thence south nineteen (19) rods and fourteen (14) feet to place of beginning containing seven and one half (7 1/2) acres more or less, Together with all and singular the tenements here sitments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining.

This conveyance is intended as a mortgage to secure the payment of nine hundred and twenty five dollars gold coin of the United States together with interest thereon in like gold coin at the rate of 8 per cent per annum from from date until paid according to the terms and conditions of two certain promissory notes bearing date hereof made by said first parties payable to the order of Sylvester A. Skinner, and these presents shall be void if such payment be made according to the terms and conditions thereof. But in case default shall be made in the payment of the principal or interest or any part thereof when the same shall be due and payable according to the terms and conditions thereof then the said party of the second part his executors administrators or assigns are hereby empowered to sell the said premises with all and every of the appurtenances or any part thereof in the manner provided by law and out of the money arising from such sale, retain the said principal and interest whethere the same shall then be due or not, together with the costs and charges of making such sale, and the overplus if any there be, shall be paid by the party making such sale on demand to the said parties of the first part their heirs or assigns. And in any suit or other proceedings that may be had for the recovery of said principal sum and interest on either said notes or this mortgage, it shall and may be lawful for the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns to include in the judgment that may be recovered counsel fees and charges of attorneys and counsel employed in such foreclosure suit the sum of seventy five dollars (or in case settlement or payment being made after suit has been commenced and before the final decree has been entered thereon an attorneys fee of fifty dollars) as well as all payments that the said party of the second part his heirs or assigns may be obliged to make for his or their security by insurance or on account of any taxes, charges incumbrances or assessments whatsoever on the said premises or any part thereof.
