Holtgreve, where the west line of said tract intersects the North line of the County road, thence 200 feet East along said north line of the County road, thence North 217 feet, thence west to an intersection of the dividing line between said Holtgreve tract and land belonging to E. R. Minville, adjoining, thence southerly along said dividing line to place of beginning.
