## Hamilton to Bank

This Indenture made this fifteen the (15th) day of October in the year of our Lord 1910 between Maggie E. Hamilton and E. C. Hamilton her husband of Stevenson Washington, parties of the first part and Bank of Stevenson a Washington corporation, party of the second part witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars lawful money of the United States to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and to its successors and assigns the following described tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington and bounded and described as follows to-wit:

All that portion of Astatten, eleven and twelve in section thirty six (36) Township three (3) North of range seven and one half (7½) East of W.M. lying north of the right of way of the Spokane Portland & Seattle Ry. Co., excepting therefrom however 1.67 acres (or such portion thereof lying north of said right of way heretofore deeded to Mountain Lodge No. 172 I.O.O.F.; excepting also two acres deeded to John F. Sweeney for a more particular description of which reference is made to the records of the deed thereto on page 102 of Book I of deeds records of Skamania County Wash. Excepting also a strip of land across the same adjacent to and north of the said railway right of way deeded to J.M. Stevenson for a County Road; excepting also so much water from Nelson Creek as will flow through a one inch pipe and a right of way across the said land for a pipe line to the said Nelson Creek, together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging.
