

Thos. N. Strong & Wife to P. & S. Ry. Co.

Right of Way Deed.

The Grantors for and in consideration of the sum of Eighteen thousand (\$1800.00) Dollars, in hand paid, convey and warrant to the Portland and Seattle Railway Company, a Washington corporation, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate situate in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, viz: A right of way for its railroad consisting of a strip of land one hundred feet in width being fifty feet in width on each side of the center line of the railroad of said Railway Company, as now located and staked out and to be constructed over and across the north half of the northwest quarter and the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of section four, township one north, range six east, W.M., and also the west half of the southwest quarter of section thirty four, township two north, range six east, W.M.

Said consideration also being in full settlement of all claims and demands for damages sustained by reason of the taking and use of said strip of land for railroad purposes.

Said center line is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point known as Station 1651+34.5 on the west boundary of section four, township one north, range six east W.M., which point is 457 feet more or less south of the northwest corner of said section four; thence north $84^{\circ}30'$ east 3067.6 feet; thence on a curve to the left having a radius of 6875.5 feet a distance of 820 feet to the north boundary of said section four.

Also beginning at a point on the west boundary of section thirty four township two north, range six east, W.M., known as Station 1705+24.1, which point is 540 feet more or less north of the southwest corner of said section thirty-four; thence on a curve to the left having a radius of 6875.5 feet, a distance of 676 feet, thence north $58^{\circ}43'$ E. 824 feet to the east line of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of said section thirty-four.
