

Geo. H. Stevenson to J. H. Ginder

That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollars Gold coin of the United States of America, to him or his head paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to be these presents, remises, releases and forever quiet claim unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, the following described tract, lot or parcel of land, situated lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington, particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit: All of Lots six and seven in Block Five, Lots nineteen and twenty in Block six, Lots twenty-one, twenty-two, twenty-three, twenty-four and twenty-five in Block Six and Lots seventeen and eighteen in said Block Six all in the Town of Stevenson Washington. This conveyance is made for the purpose of releasing a Mortgage for \$750.00 which is recorded in Book "F" of Mortgages on page 434 of said Skamania County.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof. To Have and to Hold, all and singular the said premises, together with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever.
