

B. G. Shurtliff to O. & S. Ry Co.

Right of way Deed.

The Grantors, being the owners of the following described five acres tract of land situate in lot one of section twenty-nine, Township three north, range eight east of the Willamette Meridian, Skamania County, to-wit: Commencing at a point 31.69 chains east and 4.77 chains north from the section corner 29, 30, and 31 and 32 (situated at corner 20° E) thence W. 185 links to boundary Road; thence N. 16° 30' E. 208 links to boundary Road; thence N. 40° E. 407 links to Co. Road; thence N. 47° E. 205 links where line leaves Co. Road; thence S. 60° E. 446 links; thence S. 23° E. 65 links; thence S 48° E. 210 links; thence S. 61° W. 182 links; thence S. 2° E. 151 links; thence S 45° W. 180 links; thence W. 255 links to starting point, for and consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500) Dollars, in hand paid, convey and warrant to the Portland and Seattle Railway Company, a Washington corporation, its successors and assigns, that part of said five acres tract lying south of a line parallel with and distant fifty feet northerly from the center line of the Railroad of said Railway Company as now located, staked out and to be constructed over and across said lot one: and consideration also being in full settlement of all claims and demands for damage sustained by reason of the location, construction, maintenance and operation of said railroad, on, over and across said described land. Said Railway Company agrees to provide one private wagon road crossing across said right of way.
