To have and to hold said railways, properties rights franchises and appurtenances hereby released and quitclaimed unto the Company, its successors and assigns for their proper use, benefit and behoof forever, free clear and discharged from all liens and claims under and by virtue of said indenture of May 1st 1908 above referred to.
