So much of a strip and tract of land 200 ft wide being 100 ft on each side of the center line of the survey of the Portland & Seattle Railway Co., as the same is now surveyed and staked out through over and across the east half of Lot one (1) and the west half of Lot two (2) Section twenty-three Township three (3) North, Range ten (10) East of the Willamette Meridian, as is contained in one entire tract extending east and west on each side of the central line of the White Salmon River and between the line of ordinary high water of the Columbia River on the North, and the Southern line of Lots one (1) and two (2), said Section twenty-three (23) as shown by the United States survey of the same or the South, said central line of said company's survey being described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the east line of the west half of lot two of said section twenty-three known and designated as station 674+40 of said railway survey; thence on a spiral curve to the right 30.8 feet, thence north 69° 41' west 645.2 feet, thence on a curve to the left having a radius of 5730 feet a distance of 709 feet to a point on the west line of the east half of lot one of said section twenty-three, known and designated as station 688+25 of said railway survey, whence the northwest corner of said lot one bears north 35° 30' west 1136.9 feet.
