Wills of Stevens, State of Washington, party of the second part, have Deed, Bargained and Sold and by these presents Do Grant, Assign, Sell and Convey unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, the following described real property, situate, lying and being in the County of Stevens, State of Washington, to-wit: All that Right of Way for a wagon road conveyed by Deed from H. L. Powers to John Cotton, April 26th 1902 and described as a right of way for access and egress to the northwest quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of northeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) by means of wagon road suitable convenient and necessary over the northeast quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty - seven ($\frac{1}{4}$) Twp 3 N of Range 9 E. W. M.

To Have and to Hold, the said premises, with all their appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever; and this said John T. Cotton and wife parties of the first part for themselves and for their heirs, executors and administrators do hereby covenant to and with the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, that they are the owners in fee simple of said premises, and that they are free from all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the title thereto against all lawful claims whatsoever.
