Know all men by these Presents: That we P. C. Mitchell and Jane A. Sealed with our hands and seals and dated the 29th day of February one thousand nine hundred and six.

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bonders P. C. Mitchell and Jane A. Mitchell shall on the 15th day of June one thousand nine hundred and eight make, execute and deliver unto the said William Kirkman (provided that the said William Kirkman shall, on or before that day, have paid to the said P. C. Mitchell and Jane A. Mitchell the sum of One hundred and twenty-five (\$125.00) Dollars (to be paid in two installments, to-wit: \$65.00 on or before June 15th, 1907 and \$60.00 on or before June 15th 1908, both payments to draw interest at 10% per annum until paid)) the premises agreed to be paid therefor by William Kirkman) a good and sufficient conveyance, with the usual covenants, of the following described real premises, situate, lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit: The Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section twenty-four in Township three north of range seven and one half East N. M., then their obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
