The Grantees for and in consideration of the sum of Six hundred no-100 Dollars in hand paid, coming and delivered to the Portland and Seattle Railway Company a Washington corporation, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate situate in the County of Clatsop State of Washington, viz:

A strip of land one hundred feet in width being fifty feet in width on each side of the center line of the Railroad of said Railway Company, as now located, stated and said to be constructed over and across Lots one (1) and two (2) of Section twenty-one Township three (3) North, Range, ten (10) East of the Willamette Meridian and the standards adjacent thereto, including the unpasses right of the grantees herein to purchase the portion of said shore lands contained within said strip, said consideration also being in full settlement of all claims and demands for damage sustained by reason of the location construction, maintenance and operation of said railroad on, over and across said described land.

Said Railway Company to build a grade crossing over the track for said grantees at some practicable point on said strip.
