All my right, title and interest in and to a strip of land one hundred feet in width, being fifty feet in width on each side of the center line of the railroad of said Railway Company, as now located, staked out and to be constructed over and across Lots one (1) and two (2) Section Twenty-one (21) Township three (3) North Range ten (10) East, Williamson, Marion, and the boundaries adjacent thereto, including the preference right of the grantors herein to purchase the portions of said boundaries contained in said strip, said consideration also being in full settlement of all claims and demands for damage sustained by reason of the location, construction, maintenance and operation of said railroad, on, over and across said described land.
