

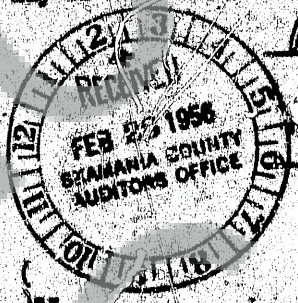
DECLARATION OF PARTNERSHIP

This Declaration of Partnership was entered into this 9th day of February, 1956, by and between William E. Sprinkle and Archie J. Maus heretofore doing business under the partnership name of "Columbia Theater":

WITNESSETH:

1. The partnership of William E. Sprinkle and Archie J. Maus organized on September 20, 1945, for the purpose of conducting a theater business at North Bonneville in Skamania County, Washington, is hereby terminated and dissolved.
2. By a deed of even date herewith title to all partnership real property has been conveyed to William E. Sprinkle, and it is understood that all partnership assets have been purchased by William E. Sprinkle and that he shall be entitled to carry on said theater business as a sole proprietorship.
3. It is understood that dissolution of said partnership is by mutual consent of the partners, and that all expenses hereafter incurred by William E. Sprinkle in the conduct of said theater business shall be his separate obligations.

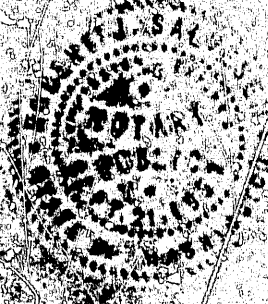
